**North Carolina Department of Transportation TIGER II Discretionary  
Grant Program Letter of Project Support**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) has received a request for TIGER II Discretionary Grant Program support from the Town of Cary, North Carolina. The Town of Cary has developed and plans to submit an application for the following project:

The Walker Street Extension project is approximately 0.20 miles in length and will extend from Chatham Street to Chapel Hill Road located in downtown Cary. The roadway extension will be complete with bike lanes and wide pedestrian sidewalks. A railroad grade separation bridge will be provided for CSXT Rail, Norfolk Southern Rail, North Carolina Rail Road, and Triangle Transit Authority. The project will provide safety benefits associated with rail traffic separation, relieve area-wide congestion, improve emergency vehicle response, and enhance economic re-development in nearby downtown Cary.

Based on our review of the project and knowledge of TIGER II Discretionary Grant Program requirements, the NCDOT does hereby support the Town of Cary, North Carolina in their efforts to obtain a TIGER II Grant.
