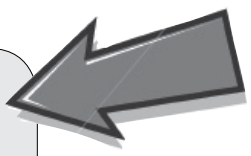

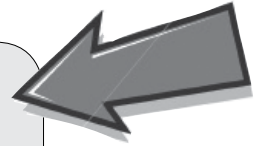

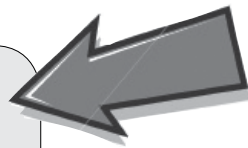
## Junior Tennis Camp (age 8-13)
