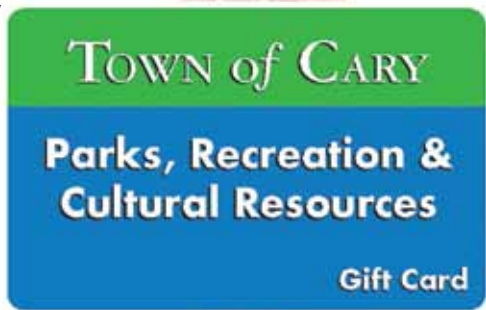
**DON'T WAIT!**
