



The **Cary Tennis Park** is a national leader in the area of tennis player development. The Tennis Park staff has created a comprehensive pathway for children of all ages and abilities which provide the necessary skills, introducing them to an active lifestyle through the sport of tennis.

The **Cary Tennis Park Player Development Program** emphasizes competition and training formats tailored to the age of the child. Each of the classes listed in this section will incorporate the following four components:

- Independent racquet and ball coordination; participants will work individually on eye hand coordination skills
- Cooperative training; participants will work together to develop basic rally skills
- Technical skill development; fundamental stroke development, and footwork skills will be taught
- Interactive games and play

The **Town of Cary maintains 58 courts at five locations:** Annie Jones Park, Dunham Park, Godbold Park, Middle Creek School/Park, and the Cary Tennis Park. Four courts are 36' for the eight and under play format and 54 courts are 78'. In addition, 20 courts have been lined for the ten and under 60' play format.

The Town's main tennis facility is the Cary Tennis Park, which is the state's largest public outdoor tennis facility. The park is a full service facility on approximately 24 acres in western Cary. Amenities include locker rooms with showers, meeting room, snack bar and clubhouse. The park provides a comprehensive array of tennis programs, events and services for beginner through advanced players.

Since opening, the Cary Tennis Park has expanded the tennis offerings in the community to include private lessons, group clinics and league play. The Cary Tennis Park is host to several national, regional and state tournaments including the Bullfrog USTA Southern Section Designated, NC Junior Closed State Tournament, Boys and Girls 14 USTA National Zone Team Championships, the Men's and Women's ACC Championships and the Western Wake Charity Event to benefit Hospice hosted with the Western Wake Tennis Association.

Cary Tennis Academy

Looking for a more advanced tennis experience? Join the Cary Tennis Academy, at the Cary Tennis Park. For more information on dates, times and fees call (919) 462-2061.



Registration for Academy programs is only available in person at the Tennis Park. The Tennis Park staff must approve all juniors placed in these programs.


Talent ID (age 5-8)

Talent ID is for youth interested in tennis. The program will focus on establishing a strong technical foundation and develop basic agility and movement skills. Program members are expected to compete in Junior Team Tennis and 8 and local tournaments.


Academy I (age 8-10)

Academy I is for the intermediate tennis player interested in participating in tournament play. Stroke development, consistency and basic strategy will be emphasized. Juniors are expected to meet a USTA tournament participation requirement to remain in the program.


Academy Select (age 11-18)

 Academy Select is designed for the established tournament junior who has aspirations of playing college tennis. Juniors must have a state and sectional ranking and be working toward a national ranking. Participants are expected to implement advanced strategies in a variety of live ball drills.

Junior Competition (age 11-18)

 Junior Competition is structured for the present high school player or those aspiring to make the team. Drills will be structured around playing situations and point development. Stroke mechanics will be stressed along with the improvement of the serve.

High School Team (age 14-18)

 High School Team is designed for the high school varsity player who wants to keep his or her game tuned-up for the upcoming season. Juniors are expected to be able to hit with spin and change direction of the ball. The player rarely double faults and is becoming an all-around player. Drills will be designed around execution, and the ability to close out points.

CTP Challenge Ladder

The CTP provides a ten week Competitive Singles Ladder for adults. Players set up their own matches at their convenience and can play as often as they like. Players earn points for challenges to move higher on the ladder. Levels are determined by using NTRP system. Registration for the Challenge Ladder begins four weeks before the official start date of the program. Registration is a two-fold process. First stop by the CTP and complete the registration form, sign waiver and pay the fee, then register online at www.townofcary.org. Players may join for up to four weeks after the start of the ladder.
