Materials Accepted in Your Recycling Cart/Bin

CHIPBOARD *(flat and brown when torn)*

- Paper towel rolls, shoe boxes, cereal, cracker and similar food boxes.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD *(wavy middle)*

- Shipping boxes

Remove and properly dispose of all packing material. Flatten and/or cut to ensure that it fits in the cart. Customers using a recycling bin must flatten and/or cut cardboard into pieces no larger than 2'X3' in size and place pieces inside the bin. If you have more corrugated cardboard than can fit in your cart/bin, call (919) 469-4090 to schedule a free pickup. **Not accepted: pizza boxes.**

SBS/WHITE PAPERBOARD *(flat and white when torn)*

- Pharmaceutical paperboard packaging such as an acetaminophen or ibuprofen box.

PAPER

- Newspaper & inserts, flyers, glossy magazines/catalogues
- Junk mail, including envelopes w/ clear windows and postcards
- Manila envelopes
- Telephone books
- White & color paper
- Fax paper
- Card stock
- Greeting cards (non-musical recording)
- Non-foil gift wrap

Not accepted: shredded paper, books, paper/binder clips, napkins, tissues, paper towels, wax or parchment paper.

PLASTIC

- Plastic bottles and tubs #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7. **Not accepted: unnumbered plastics, frozen entrée trays or microwavable food trays, takeout "clamshell" containers, plastic bags, toys, coat hangers, and bottles/tubs that previously contained hazardous materials such as pesticides and automotive fluid. No Styrofoam.**

GLASS **clear, brown & green**

- Bottles and jars. **Not accepted: no ceramic, Pyrex, window/auto or mirror glass, lightbulbs, and broken glass.**

ASEPTIC PACKAGING

- Drink boxes and soup boxes. **Not accepted: straws, liquid, and drink pouches such as Capri Sun packages.**

METAL

- Aluminum cans, foil, pie pans, and tin/steel food cans. **Not accepted: food residue and household items such as cooking pots.**

GABLE TOP CARTONS

- Milk and juice cartons

REMEMBER to prepare your recyclables properly.
Please discard all lids and rinse containers. Labels are okay.
