The class started with the instructor Larry Zoller giving some background information on birds and their ecosystems. An interactive fun game was played by the kids. Later on, the group moved outdoors where Larry demonstrated how to assemble the birdhouses. Three work stations, stocked with necessary tools and supplies had been arranged for participants to construct their birdhouses. It was heartening to see young kids hammering nails and using the drill for their birdhouse along with their parent. Strong precautions were taken that each kid was always supervised by an adult. Weather was nice and sunny which definitely added to the fun at this winter time of the year. Excellent feedback was received from all participants.
