## Brannif Drive Transitional Housing

*The Caring Place began operations in May 1993 in Cary, as a part of Christian Community In Action. From those roots, it grew into a stand-alone non-profit housing organization based in Cary. To date, they have worked with over 350 families to provide transitional housing as a stepping stone from homelessness to independent living. With CDBG funding support, they were able to purchase and renovate an existing duplex to provide housing for two families that allowed them to move from a homeless shelter to their own home.*
