The Caring Place began operations in May 1993 in Cary, as a part of Christian Community In Action. From those roots, it grew into a stand-alone non-profit housing organization based in Cary. To date, they have worked with over 350 families to provide transitional housing as a stepping stone from homelessness to independent living. With CDBG funding support, they were able to purchase and renovate a duplex at 114/116 Karen Ct. to provide housing for two families that allowed them to move from a homeless shelter to their own home.
