DHIC (originally the Downtown Housing Investment Corporation) partnered with the Town of Cary and Wake County to build four new homes on Hunter Street in downtown Cary. Completed in 2002, these homes featured custom architect designs reflecting “Old Cary” style. This project helped encourage the redevelopment of the neighborhood and attracted additional investment by providing 4 new affordable family homes for sale.
