Subject: **Holly Brook Water and Sewer Extension Project**

Dear OWNERWHOLE:

Committed to keeping you informed of construction activities as the Town of Cary begins the work of extending water and sewer services to the Holly Brook subdivision, we are providing you this update. Over the next few weeks, a contractor working on behalf of the Town will test portions of the water main along Kildaire Farm Road. During that time, you may notice water along Holly Brook Drive as a result of flushing of the newly-installed water main.

To ensure your safety and the safety of our contractors, beginning the week of January 2, 2018 Holly Brook Drive will be closed to through traffic from Kildaire Farm Road to Inkberry Court as contractors work to install water lines in the area. Residents along Holly Brook Drive will continue to have access; detour signs will be posted for all other drivers to use Brook Cross Drive. While we will not be able to eliminate inconveniences, we are working diligently to ensure that they are as minor as possible.

As we get closer to the start of construction, you may receive door hangar notices about work planned on your street or adjacent to your property. Thank you for your support as utilities are installed in Holly Brook.
