

# Picnic Shelter Rental Information Sheet

- Picnic shelters are available year-round on a first come, first use basis.
- Cary residents may reserve 6 months in advance / nonresidents may reserve shelters 5 months in advance.
- Full fee is due at booking. Renters will be charged for any damages that may occur during the rental.
- A cancellation fee of \$25 will be charged to the renter for cancellations within 30 days of the reservation. Cancellations within 5 working days will result in forfeiture of all rental fees.
- Grills are allowed and must be located at least 10' from the shelter and placed on a non-combustible surface such as grass or concrete (not mulch or pine straw).

Non Peak (November-March): Full Day Only 9 a.m.-5 p.m.

**JACK SMITH, November-March ONLY (9725 Penny Rd, Cary).....capacity 20**  
Features include Sprayground Park which is operational mid-May thru mid-September. Access to restrooms and grill. Shelter is available for reservations November 1-March 31. Due to Sprayground operations, **we do not accept reservations April 1-October 31.**

**BUEHLER SHELTER (Bond Park, 801 High House Rd, Cary)..... capacity 50**  
Located at Bond Park. Access to restroom, electricity, lights, water and a grill.

**SCREENED PORCH (Bond Park, 801 High House Rd, Cary)..... capacity 20**  
Located within Bond Park adjacent to the Boathouse. Can accommodate small parties and includes rocking chairs that overlook the lake. Access to restroom, electricity, lights, and water.

**NEW HOPE CHURCH ROAD TRAILHEAD PARK (2725 New Hope Church Rd, Cary).... capacity 30**  
Located at intersection of American Tobacco Trail and New Hope Church Rd. Access to restrooms. Parking available for horse trailers. Access to restroom, electricity, lights, water and a grill.

**MARLA DORREL PARK (formerly Kids Together Park, 111 Thurston Dr, Cary)..... capacity 40**  
Located near the intersection of Cary Parkway and Tryon Road. Access to restrooms.

**DAVIS DRIVE PARK (1610 Davis Dr, Apex)..... capacity 30**  
Located on Davis Drive, near the schools. Access to restrooms.

**WHITE OAK PARK (1216 Jenks Carpenter Rd, Cary)..... capacity 40**  
Located on Jenks Carpenter Road near the Park Village Subdivision. Access to restrooms and electricity.

**PLAYGROUND SHELTER (Brooks Park, 111 Brooks Park Ave, Cary)..... capacity 40**  
Located at Thomas Brooks Park. Access to a grill.

 Located at Bond Park across from the playground. Access to restrooms, electricity, grill and lights. A brick fireplace with cooking facilities encloses one end of the shelter

**ROTARY SHELTER (Ritter Park, 301 W. Lochmere Dr, West, Cary)..... Capacity 250**  
 Located at Harold D. Ritter Park. One of the largest shelters in Wake County. Access to restrooms, lights, electricity, and a grill. Space for a smoker/cooker.
