

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Town of Cary contracts with private businesses to run a number of Town programs and camps. Play-Well TEKologies is one such business, which conducts LEGO®-themed STEM programming.

Play-Well has informed the Town that it conducted four programs for the Town in 2017 and 2018 utilizing a Play-Well employee who, in December 2018, was charged in Arizona with child molestation involving a family member.

Because you are the parent or guardian of a child who participated in one or more of the programs, we wanted to share this information with you and forward you Play-Well's letter to parents and Play-Well's statement about their employee.

We also wanted to take the opportunity to assure you that Town staff including Cary Police received no complaints or concerns by participants, parents or staff regarding these programs or the conduct of the Play-Well employee. Upon receiving the notice from Play-Well, we confirmed with Play-Well management that Play-Well neither received any complaints or concerns expressed about the employee for the programs conducted at the Town nor did it have any information about wrong-doing by the employee during the period Play-Well was conducting these programs for the Town.
