**Subject: The Reserve Traffic Calming Project – Edgemore Avenue construction notification. Town of Cary Project Number ST-1107**

Dear Cary Neighbor:

Last year Town Council approved the installation of two (2) traffic circles on Edgemore Avenue at Briardale Road as part of the Traffic Calming program. This project was awarded to Narron Construction, Inc, at a cost of \$76,082.50 and will be conducting the work, which is set to begin the middle of September and finishing by the middle of October.

Once complete, the project will provide traffic calming devices on Edgemore Avenue at both of the Briardale Avenue intersections. More information can be found on the Town of Cary website such as design specifications and traffic study results. We know how important this roadway is to you and so many who travel in and through Cary each day, which is why we've asked the contractor to do everything possible to complete this project as soon as possible and with minimal delay.

**Briardale Avenue (T-Intersection closest to NC-55) closure**

This intersection will be closed from September 16<sup>th</sup> thru September 25<sup>th</sup> to safely complete all work. This closure is necessary to construct the traffic circle. Wake County Transportation, Public Safety and Solid Waste Department have been notified and they've agreed to plan accordingly by adjusting their routing during this time period to ensure services are not delayed during the closure.

**Briardale Avenue (4 Way Intersection closest to Sears Farm Rd)**

This intersection will remain open during the entire project. This will also include some minor sidewalk concrete work along the relocation of the crosswalk and stop bar on the west side of the Briardale Avenue leg. Construction of the traffic circle at this intersection is tentatively scheduled from September 25<sup>th</sup> to October 4<sup>th</sup>. The internal portion of the intersection closure is necessary to construct the traffic circle.

**Staying Informed**

Our goal is to complete this project with minimum inconvenience to you and your family. To update local businesses, churches and residents during the project, work zone signs will be placed along NC-55, Edgemore Avenue and Sears Farm Road and traffic alerts will be sent to local media and also available on the Town's website.
