We were not in favor of the "Roundabouts" but on further research it does seem to slow traffic down. If that is the goal, then that seems to be a good solution since there is not enough traffic for a light.

Our main concern is that we have 3 large, old oaks (100+ years) near the road we feel would be threatened by putting in the sidewalks & bike lanes. We added 10 ft to the existing right of way before we planted a wax-leaf ligustrum hedge to protect the trees and our property from noise, debris & accidents. So far that has done the trick though we had one accident that took some small trees and part of the hedge had to be replaced. We would hate to lose these valuable trees. We have kept about 1/2 of our property in it's natural state.
